COURSE HIGHLIGHTS

Training and Development

This course explores methods utilized to train and develop employees in ways that positively affect organizational outcomes and success.

Negotiations and Conflict Management

The Negotiations course introduces students to the theory and practice of negotiation specific to business. The course focuses on understanding the behavior of individuals, groups, cultures and organizations in the context of competitive situations. Students will develop analytical and interpersonal skills necessary for successful negotiations.

Strategic Management

This course provides students with advanced-level learning and critical thinking skills in the areas of strategic planning, implementation and control. An overview of historical thought in strategic management will provide a basis for students to think about and form their own theories and management styles. Both HR and management professionals are in the business of talent management. HR professionals work to identify, recruit and hire the right people for the team, while management professionals work to develop the right people into a winning team.

The BBA with a concentration in human resources and management provides students with the skills necessary to recruit and hire the right employees, to effectively develop and lead employees, and to successfully manage other organizational resources.
